Our current FMS kicked off in the last week of January. We have eight students plus 8 staff in class, representing 8 countries-of-origin plus a further two nations where these students have lived and worked extensively.

The programme is packed with teaching, tools, and workshops on family issues like marriage, parenting, divorce care, family styles, and counselling skills. The school is designed to equip students to work in Family Ministries, but it also gives the families themselves huge opportunities to deal with personal and relational issues. We are always in awe as we witness what the Lord is doing in all our students' lives.

Donations towards the cost of purchasing this van will be gratefully received.





In our previous newsletter, we described the heartwrenching journey one of our staff families has endured with their daughter's health, in the wake of her diagnosis with a rare blood disorder. Jessica Lapuz now shares the latest update about her daughter Johanna's progress;

It's been 9 months since Johanna's bone marrow transplant. She is doing well and is now being weaned off her immuno-suppressant medication. The progress of her healing has amazed even the team of nurses and doctors who were treating her. They have witnessed the power of prayer. A transplant specialist even commented, "Whatever it is you're doing, keep doing it! It's working!"



Some families who also had children in the hospital have asked for their children to be included in our prayers for healing.

It is amazing how God is glorified even in the midst of trials!! Johanna's story has encouraged others that we have a faithful, miracle-working God who hears our prayers.
